Taliesin Gilkes-Bower b.1988, USA

Gilkes-Bower works in the interference patterns between the sacred and the profane.

They transmute military industrial hardware into ceremonial tools, drawing equally from ancient shamanic lineages, science fiction, and speculative physics.

In their cosmology the multiverse is a massive "curiosity playground" through which human consciousness is but one liminal node. Gilkes-Bower's practice attends a funerary rite for the metaphysics of consensus reality.

The Surveyor returns to a depopulated Earth in the year 3025 to complete analysis of its suitability for the return of human life.

When they arrive on the surface of the planet, it becomes increasingly clear that they are somehow, improbably, alone on the wrong earth. Faced with the loss of their team, their imagined future, and cut off from the remainder of the human race, they enact a series of improvised rituals to divine the meaning of their fate.

The work is a meditation on displacement, grief, non-human intelligence, and creativity as a cycle of reception, modulation and transmission.



The DEA documents and videos were released via a FOIA request by the journalist Mattathias Schwartz and many have only been seen by the public in this installation.






